

## To the **Parents of all Fifth grade students**.

Please be aware that that the state of Kentucky requires your child to have a school physical in order to attend the Middle School. This can be done up to one year prior to enrollment. Spring break and Summer break would be a great opportunity to get this completed.

If you have already completed the KY school physical and have an updated immunization record, or you are getting this physical completed before the end of THIS school year, please be sure to turn in a copy to our school **nurse** to update your child's records and add to your child's school records. All fifth grade records will be sent on to the middle school at the end of this school year.

If you complete this during the summer, please turn your paperwork in to the Southern Middle School guidance office, in order for your child to be entered into a homeroom and receive a class schedule.

Students are required to have their shots: TDaP and Meningococcal vaccines. The HPV vaccine is optional. Immunization records have to be up to date.

The LMCA Mobile Health Clinic will be at SES on April 12th. If you are interested in your child having their physical and shots, please contact the school nurse or the clinic to set up an appointment.

Please be aware, that if your child's requirements are not complete, your child will not be placed in a homeroom or receive a schedule of classes at the middle school!
